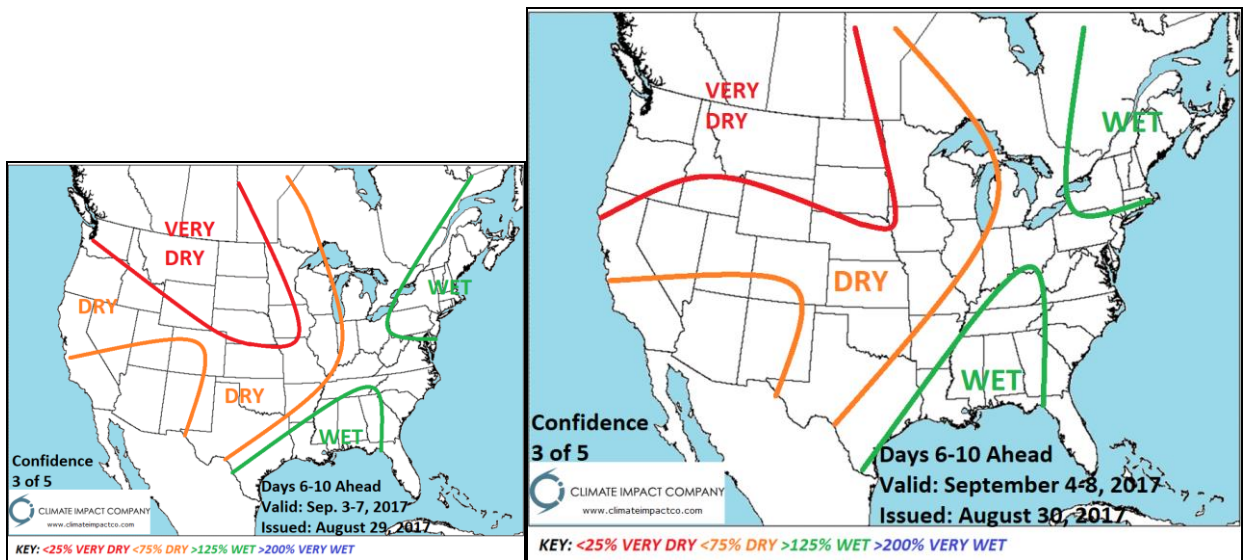

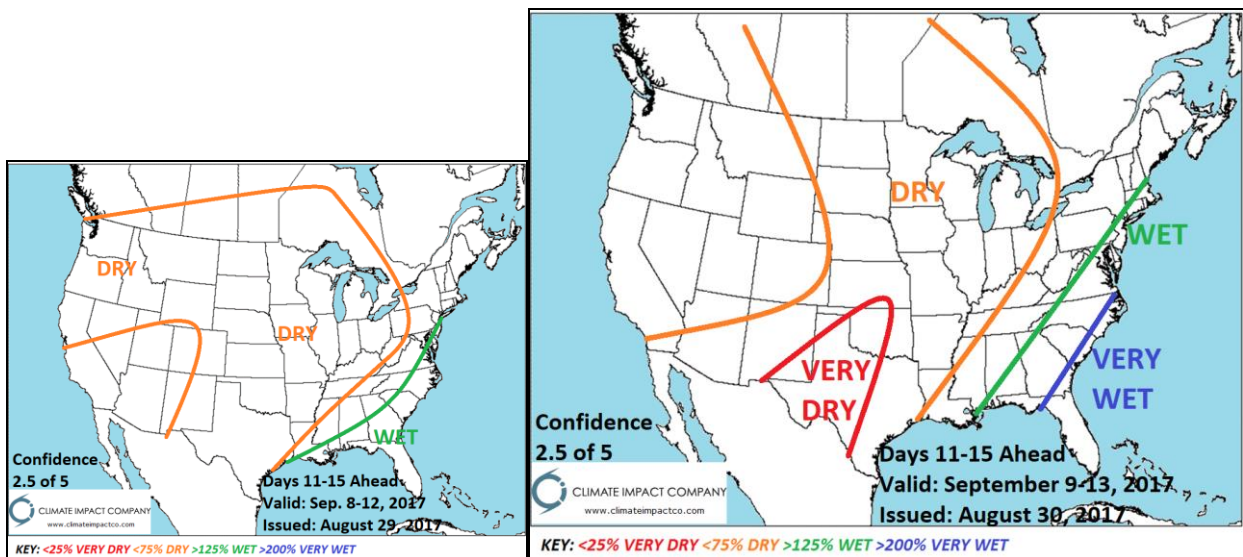

U.S. Medium/Extended-range Rainfall Forecast

Medium-range 6-10 Day Forecast Valid September 4-8, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)

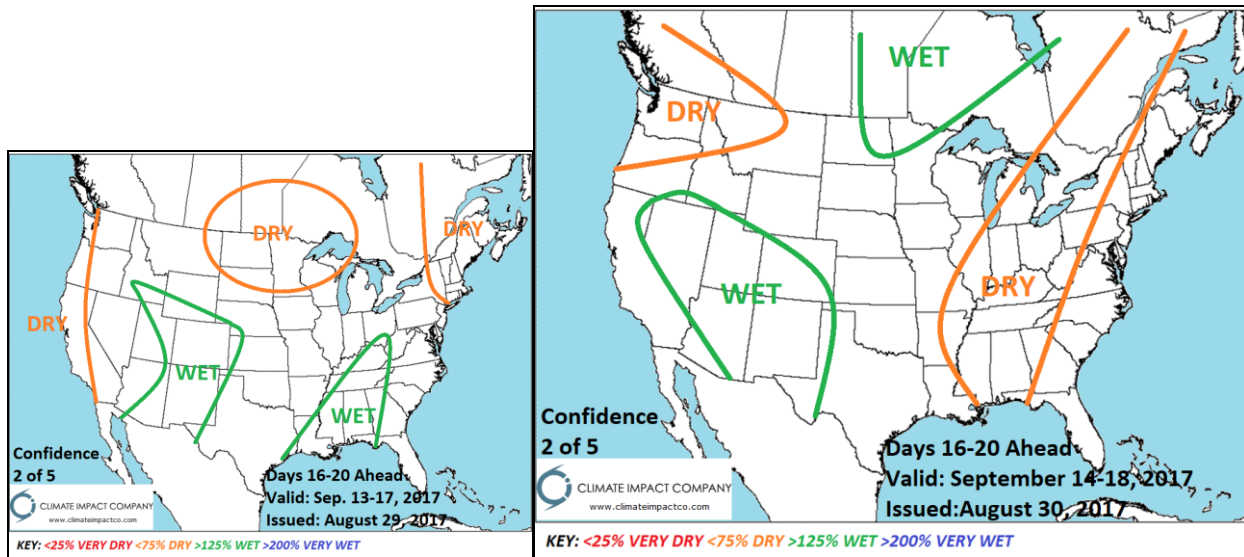


Medium-range 11-15 Day Forecast Valid September 9-13, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)



Medium-range commentary: There is risk of another weaker tropical event in the Gulf of Mexico in the 6-10 day period increasing risk of wet weather which could be heavier than indicates in the Gulf States. Risk of another tropical event brings potential excessive wet weather to the Southeast Coast days 11-15. The remainder of the U.S. is mostly dry.

Extended-range 16-20 Day Forecast Valid September 14-18, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)



Extended-range commentary: The Interior East is dry while wet weather shifts to the Southwest. The Great Plains are not as dry as a cold front extends south from Canada bringing showers.
