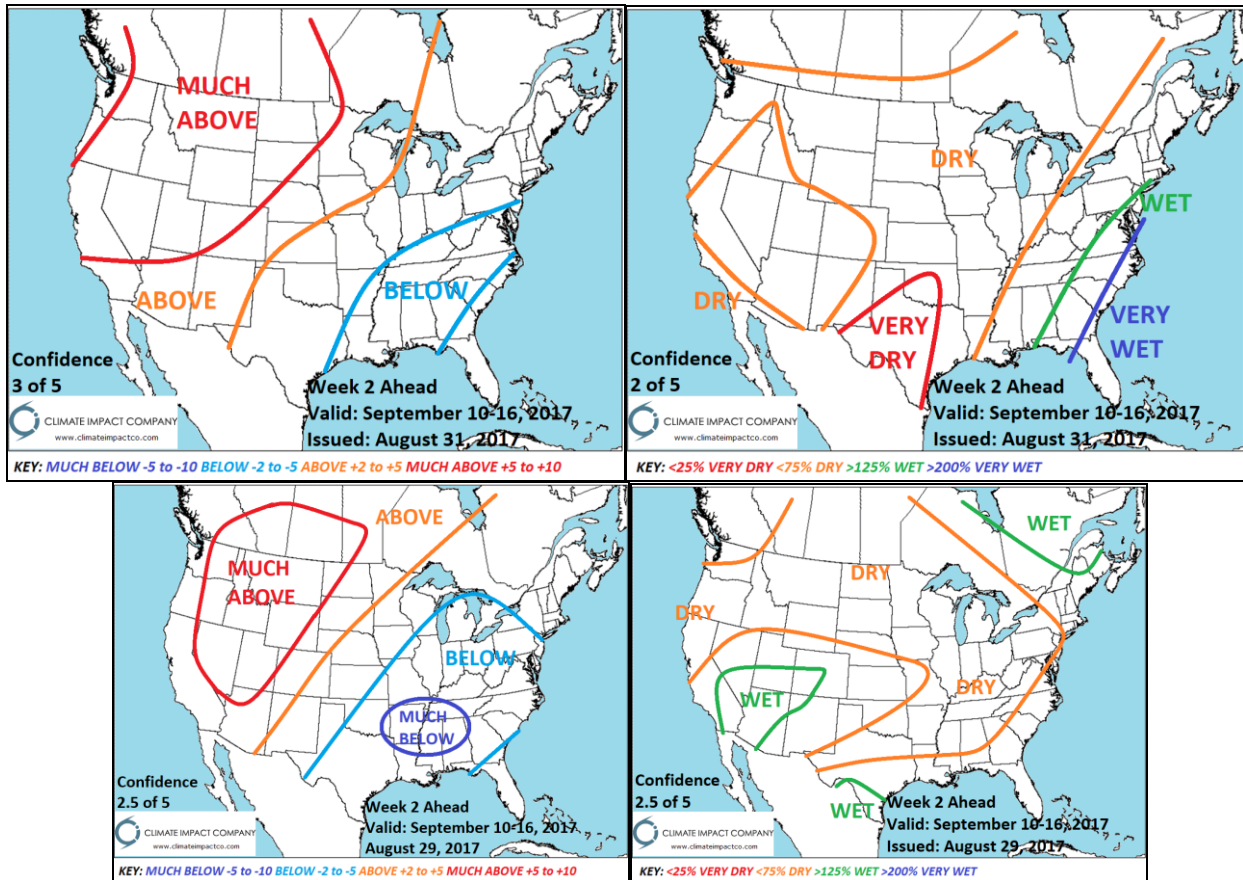


## Climate Impact Company Intra-Seasonal (Week 2-4) Outlook for the U.S.

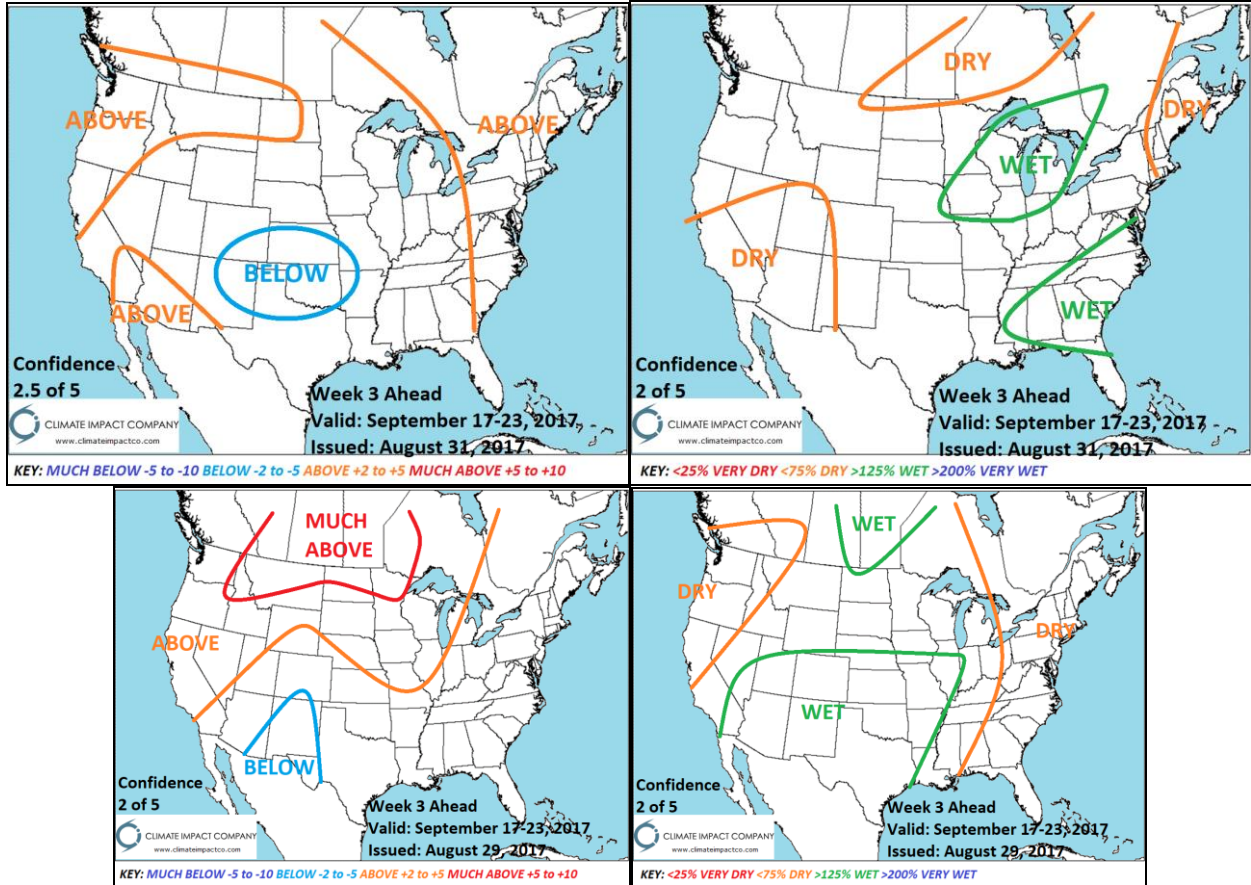

Week 2 Ahead: September 10-16, 2017 (previous forecast below)



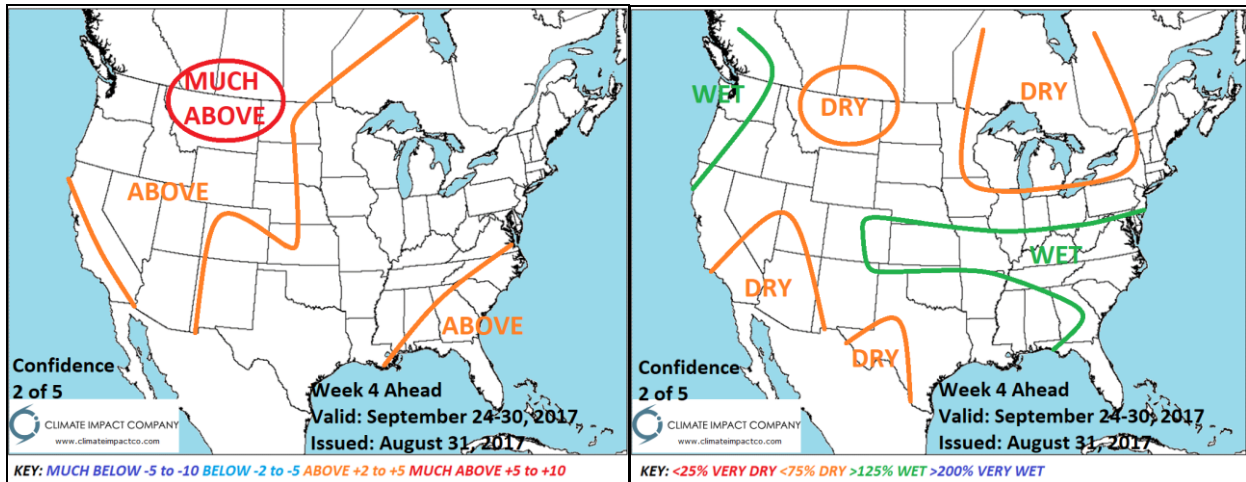
**Comment:** The outlook is dependent on influence of the tropics as Irma may strike the East or Southeast U.S. West and northwest of this potentially powerful hurricane the remainder of the U.S. is mainly drier-than-normal while the Northwest States maintain excessive heat risk.

**Week 3 Ahead: September 17-23, 2017 (previous forecast below)**



**Comment:** A warm pattern in the Northwest and East with wet condition in the Southeast and Great Lakes region.

**Week 4 Ahead: September 24-30, 2017**



**Comment:** More Northwest heat while the Mid-Atlantic/Mid-South are wet.
