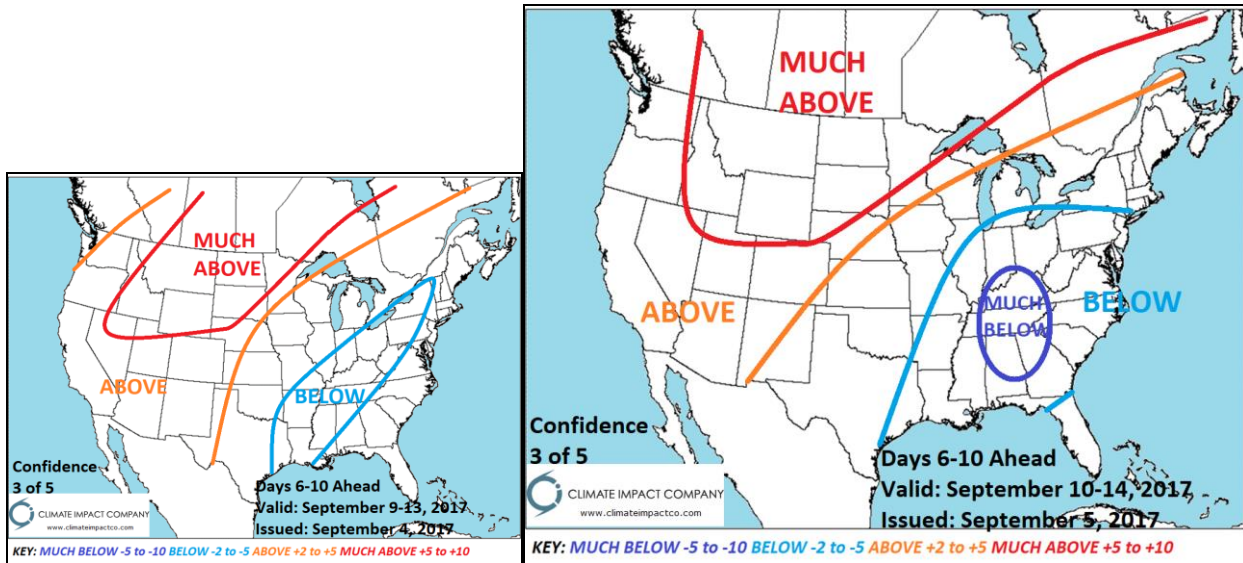


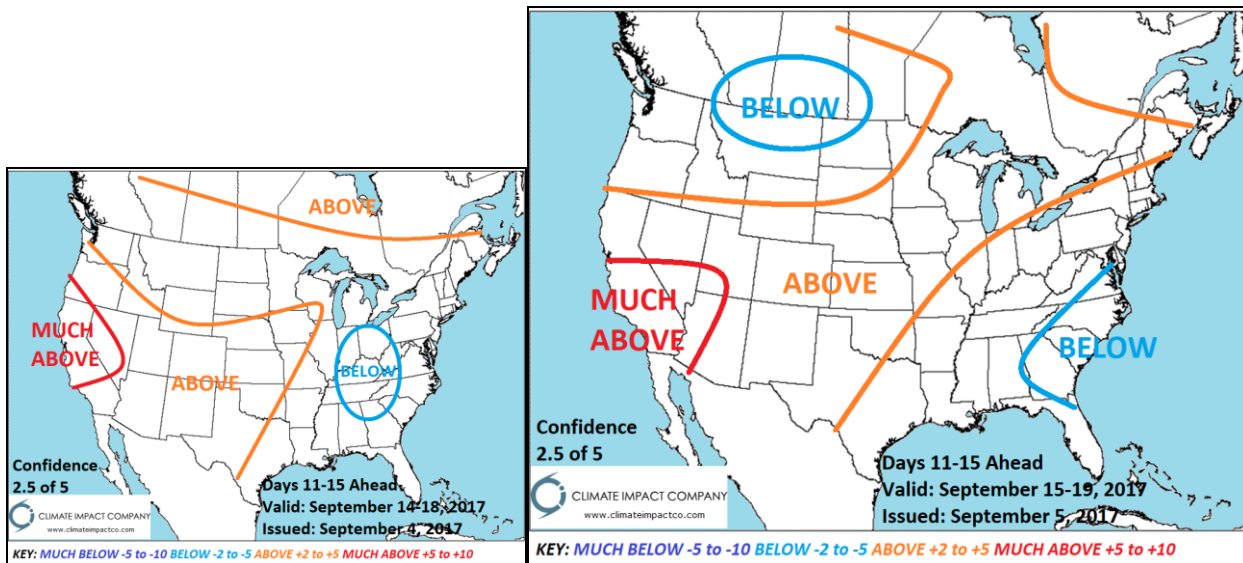
**Climate Impact Company Medium/Extended Range Forecast/Commentary**

**Medium-range 6-10 Day Forecast Valid September 10-14, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)**

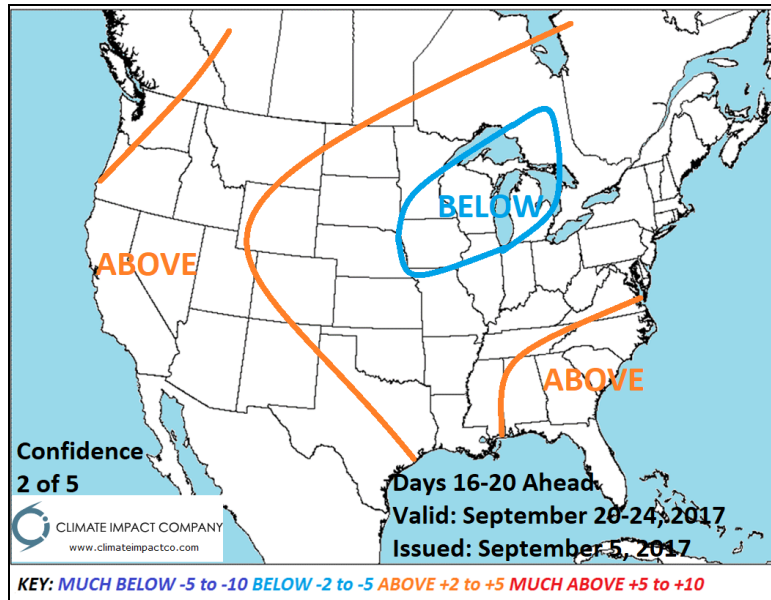


**Medium-range 11-15 Day Forecast Valid September 15-19, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)**



**Medium-range commentary:** A cool pattern in the Southeast in the 6-10 day period caused by rainfall associated with Irma. The western heat shifts northeastward and moderates. In the 11-15 day period a low confidence forecast indicates warming in the Great Plains with possible resurgent heat in California.

**Extended-range 16-20 Day Forecast Valid September 20-24, 2017**



**Extended-range commentary:** A low confidence forecast indicates a cool pattern in the Midwest while the West is warm but not excessive.
