

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

Medium-range 6-10 Day Forecast Valid September 17-21, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)




Medium-range 11-15 Day Forecast Valid September 22-26, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)




Medium-range commentary: Trending warmer Texas to the Ohio Valley ahead of a sharp cold front with a trailing chilly air mass over the Northwest in the 6-10 day period. The warm core shifts to the Midwest in the 11-15 day period while the Northwest chill expands.

Extended-range 16-20 Day Forecast Valid Sep. 27-Oct. 1, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)



Extended-range commentary: The Northwest chill strengthens while a warm pattern shifts eastward but loses its amplitude.

U.S. Medium-range Rainfall Forecasts



Comment: A La Nina-like pattern featuring a wet pattern in the Northwest including the seasons' first snowfall while the South and East are drier-than-normal.
