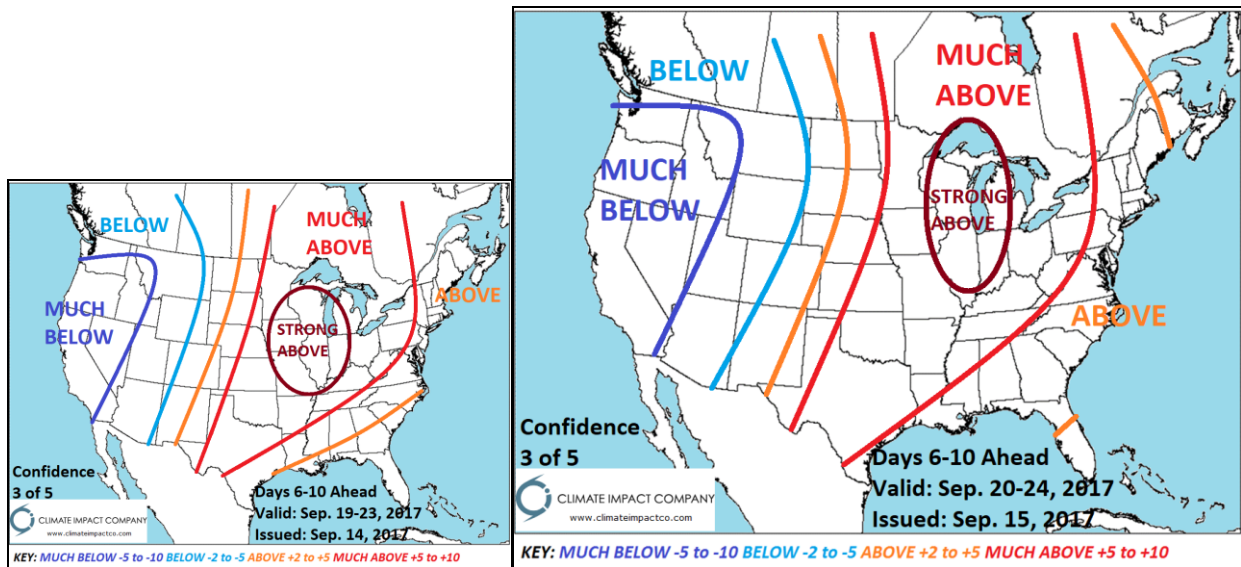


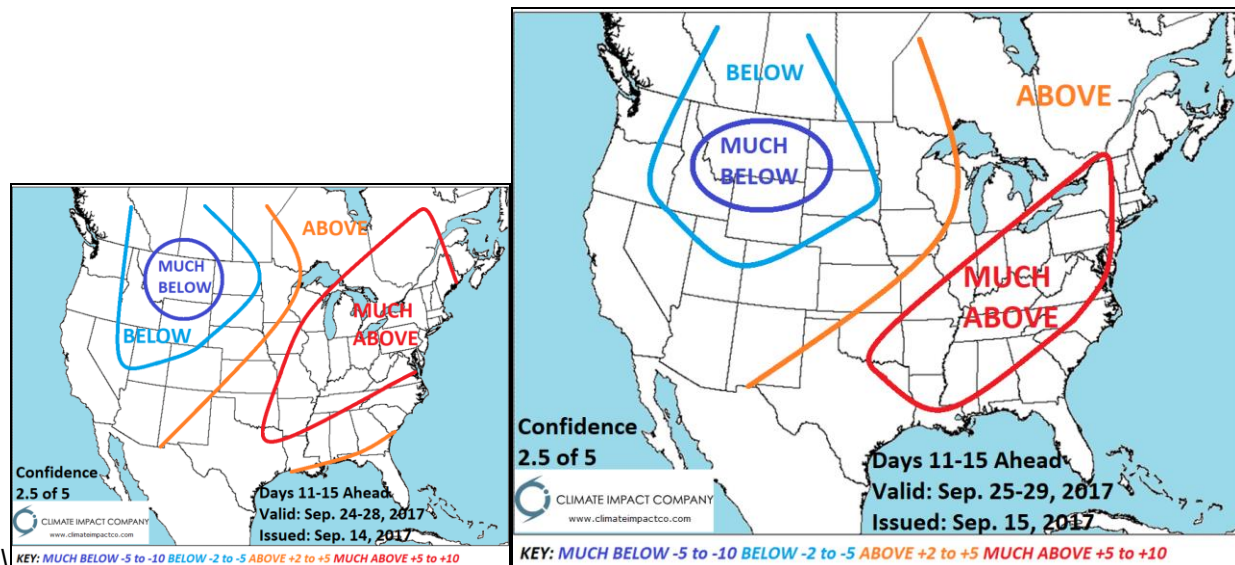
Climate Impact Company Medium/Extended Range Forecast/Commentary

Medium-range 6-10 Day Forecast Valid September 20-24, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)

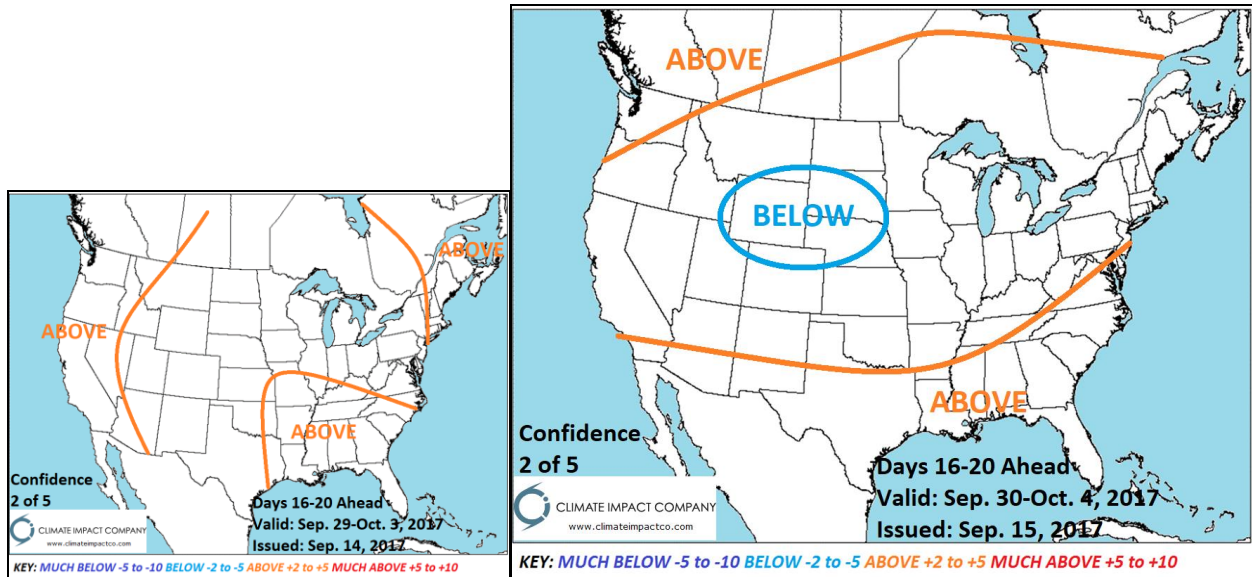


Medium-range 11-15 Day Forecast Valid September 25-29, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)



Medium-range commentary: The western trough is quasi-stationary in the West days 6-10 sustaining early season cool weather while the eastern ridge is amplified propelling possible record warmth in the Midwest. In the 11-15 day period the patten begins to break down.

Extended-range 16-20 Day Forecast Valid Sep. 30-Oct. 4, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)



Extended-range commentary: Marginally cool temperatures over parts of the Rockies receiving early season snow in early October while the anomalous warmth settles into the South U.S.
