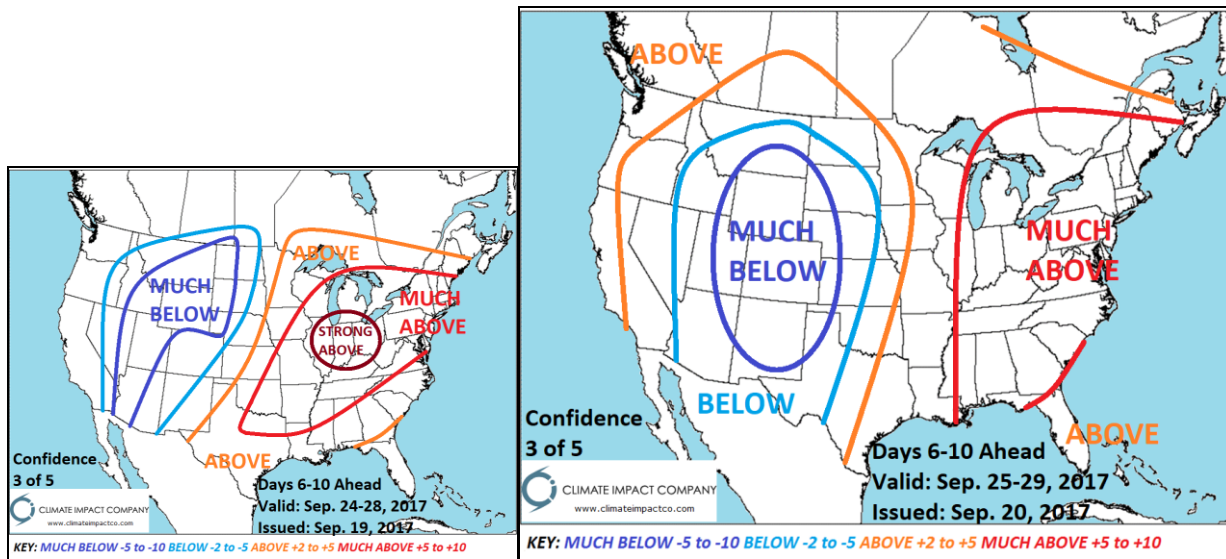


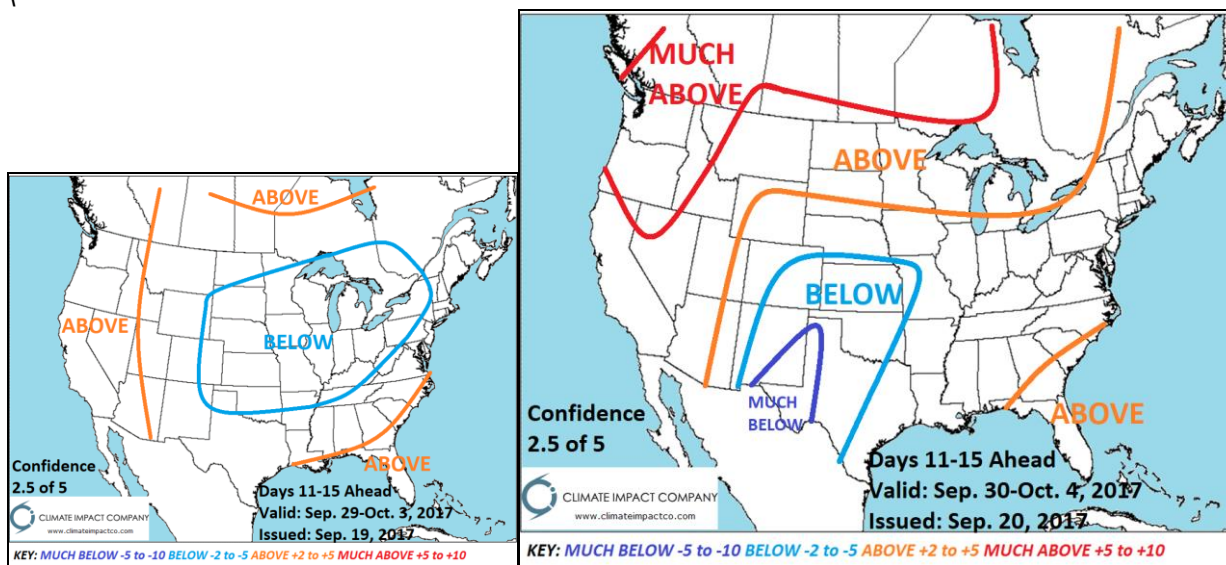

**Medium-range 6-10 Day Forecast Valid September 25-29, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)**

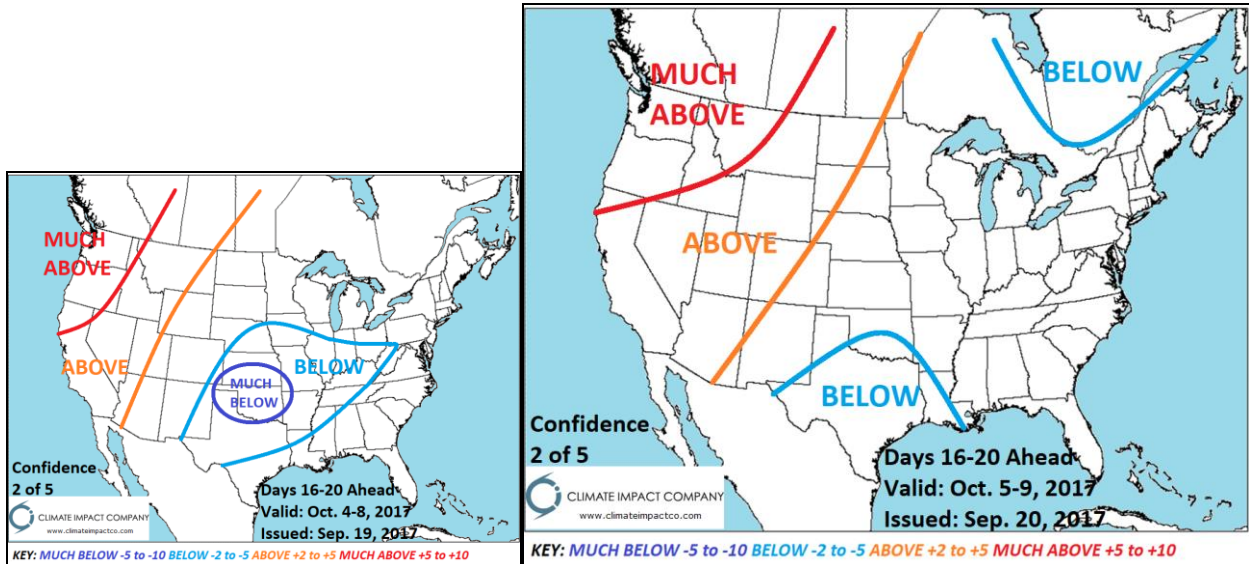


**Medium-range 11-15 Day Forecast Valid Sep. 30-Oct. 4, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)**



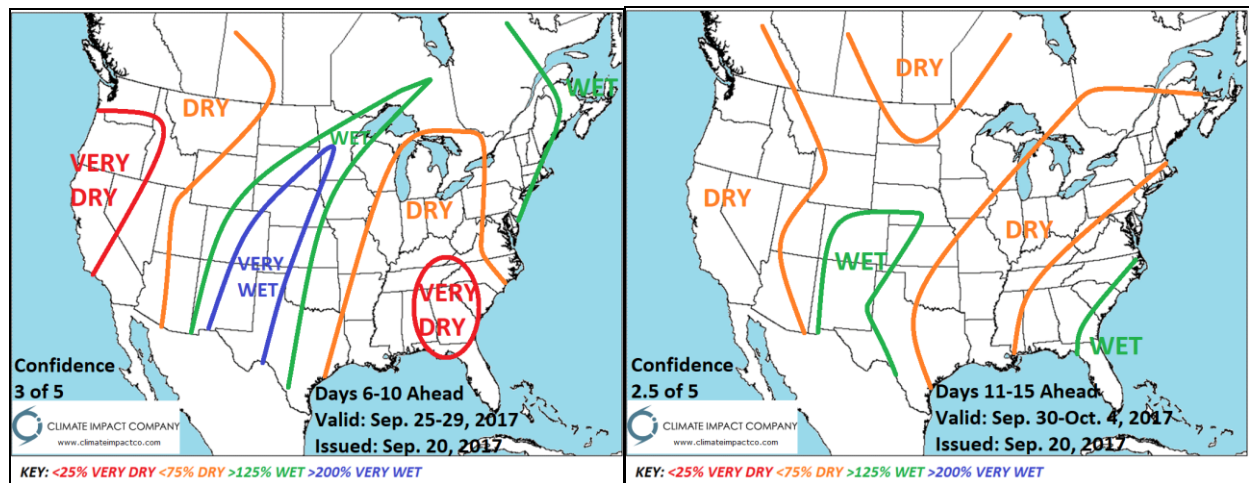
**Medium-range commentary:** The chill shifts to the West-Central U.S. while Midwest warmth rolls into the East in the 6-10 day period. Warmer across the northern U.S. in the 11-15 day period.

**Extended-range 16-20 Day Forecast Valid October 5-9, 2017 (yesterday's forecast left)**



**Extended-range commentary:** Western warmth is stronger while the Central States are less cool.

**U.S. Medium-range Rainfall Forecast**



**Discussion:** Heavy rains in the Central U.S. remain in the 6-10 day forecast caused by a slow-moving cold front. Nationally, a drier 11-15 day outlook.
