

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## **Climate Impact Company Week 2-4 Outlook for Australia**

Issued: Thursday, August 31, 2017

Week 2 Ahead: Sep. 10-16, 2017 (previous forecast below)




**Comment:** Vigorous slow-moving storm early in the period into Southeast Australia with rainfall amounts possibly higher than indicated in New South Wales. A warmer pattern in Western Australia gradually pushes warmer air eastward later next week.
