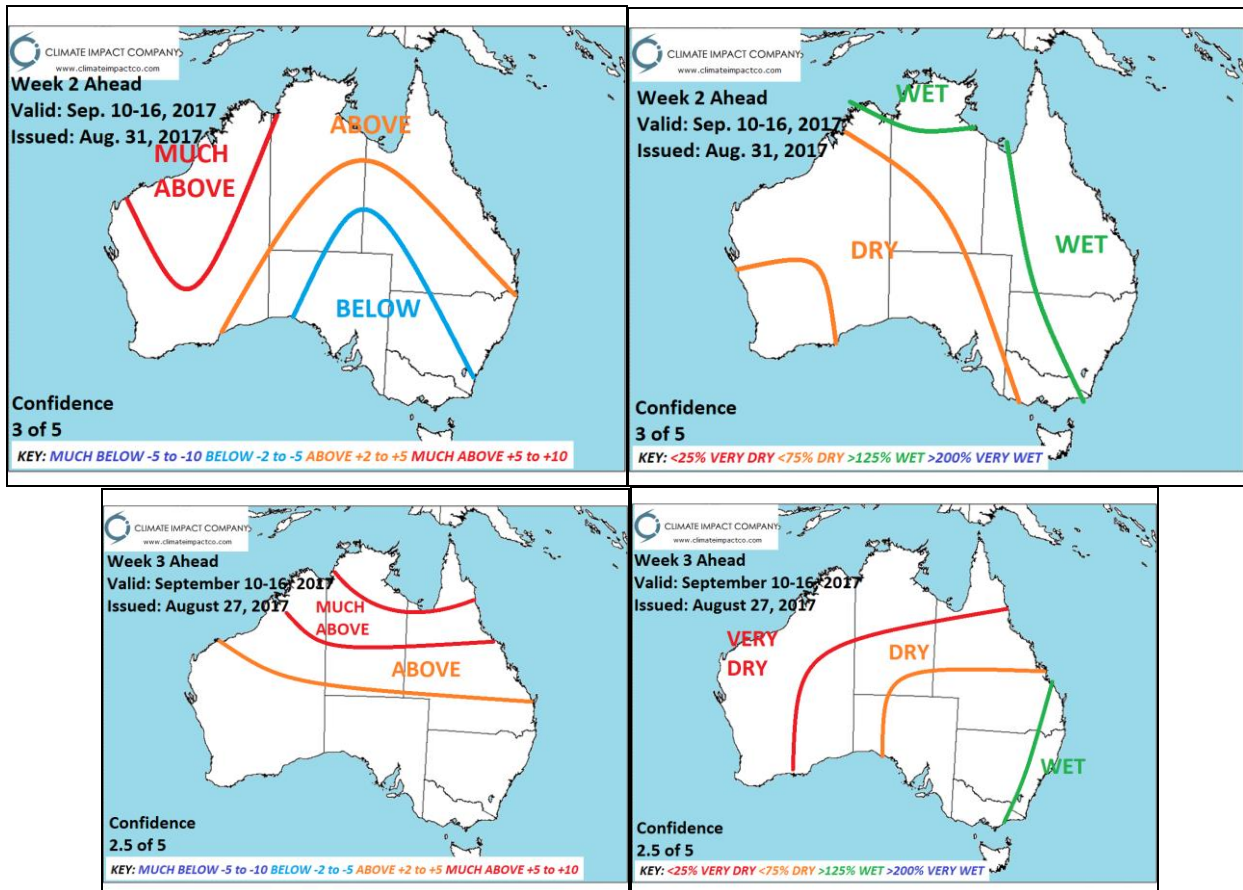


Climate Impact Company Week 2-4 Outlook for Australia

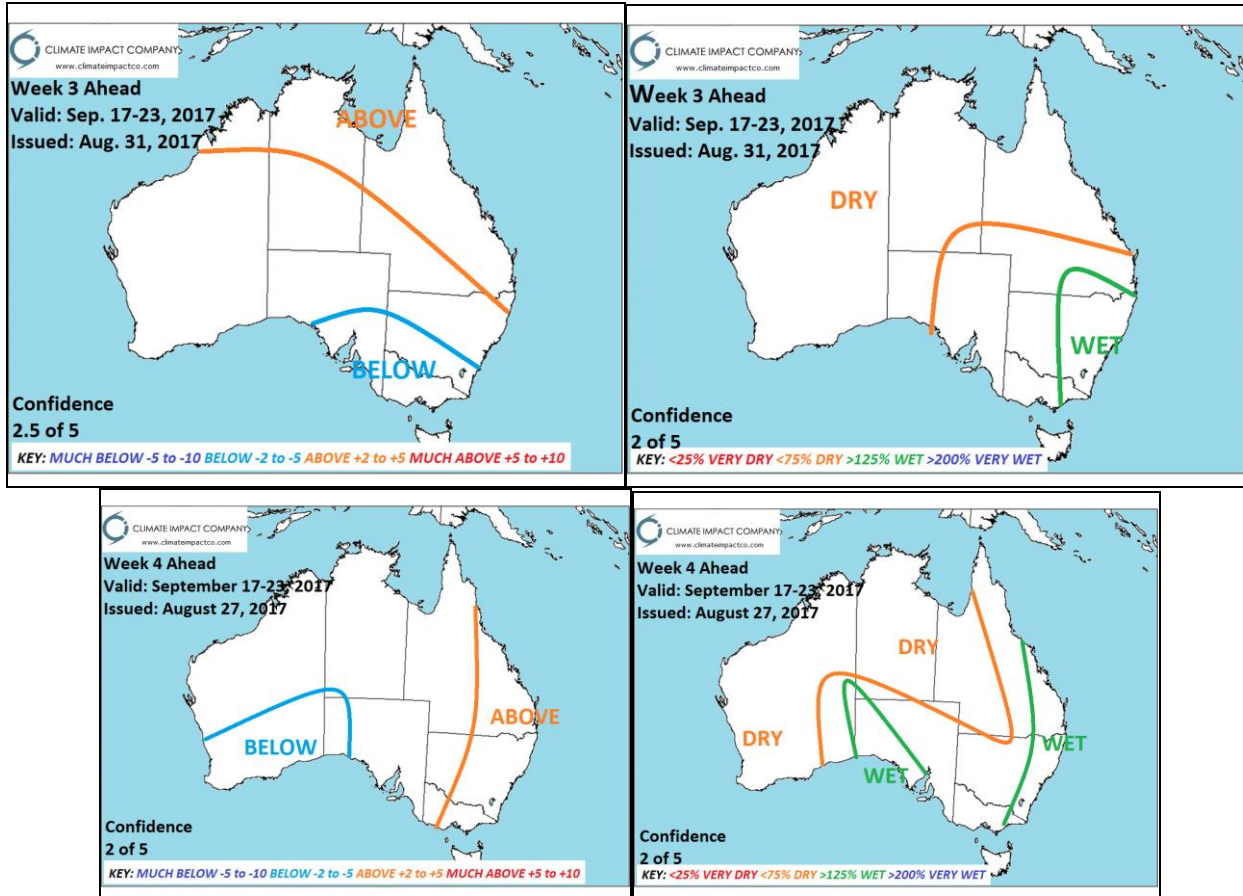

Week 2 Ahead: Sep. 10-16, 2017 (previous forecast below)



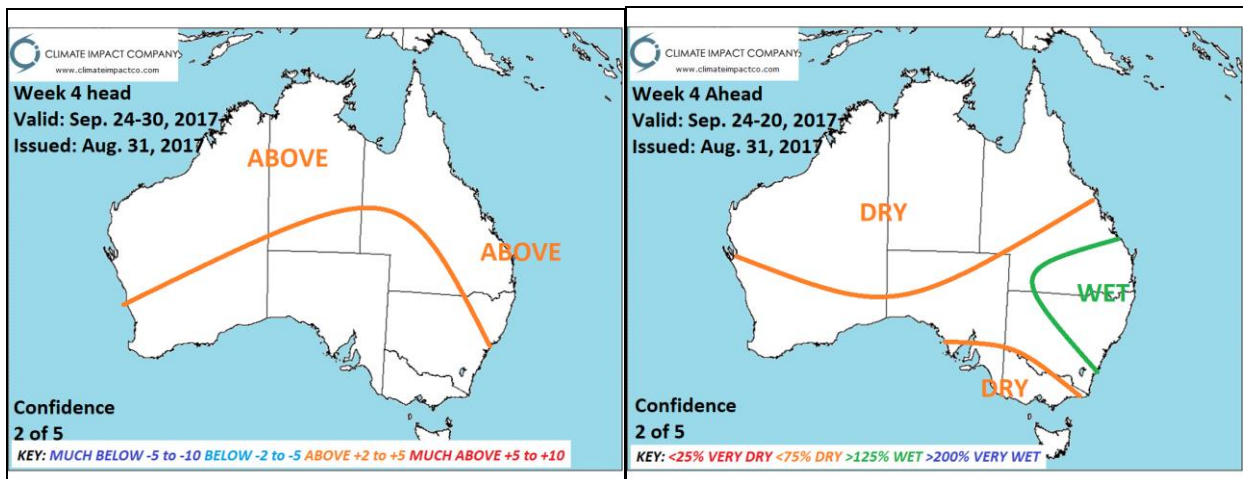
Comment: Vigorous slow-moving storm early in the period into Southeast Australia with rainfall amounts possibly higher than indicated in New South Wales. A warmer pattern in Western Australia gradually pushes warmer air eastward later next week.

Week 3 Ahead: September 17-23, 2017 (previous forecast below)



Comment: An upper trough over Southeast Australia brings rainfall while west and north continent is where the warmer/drier than normal climate is located.

Week 4 Ahead: September 24-30, 2017



Comment: The upper low remains an effective shower maker in Southeast AU.
