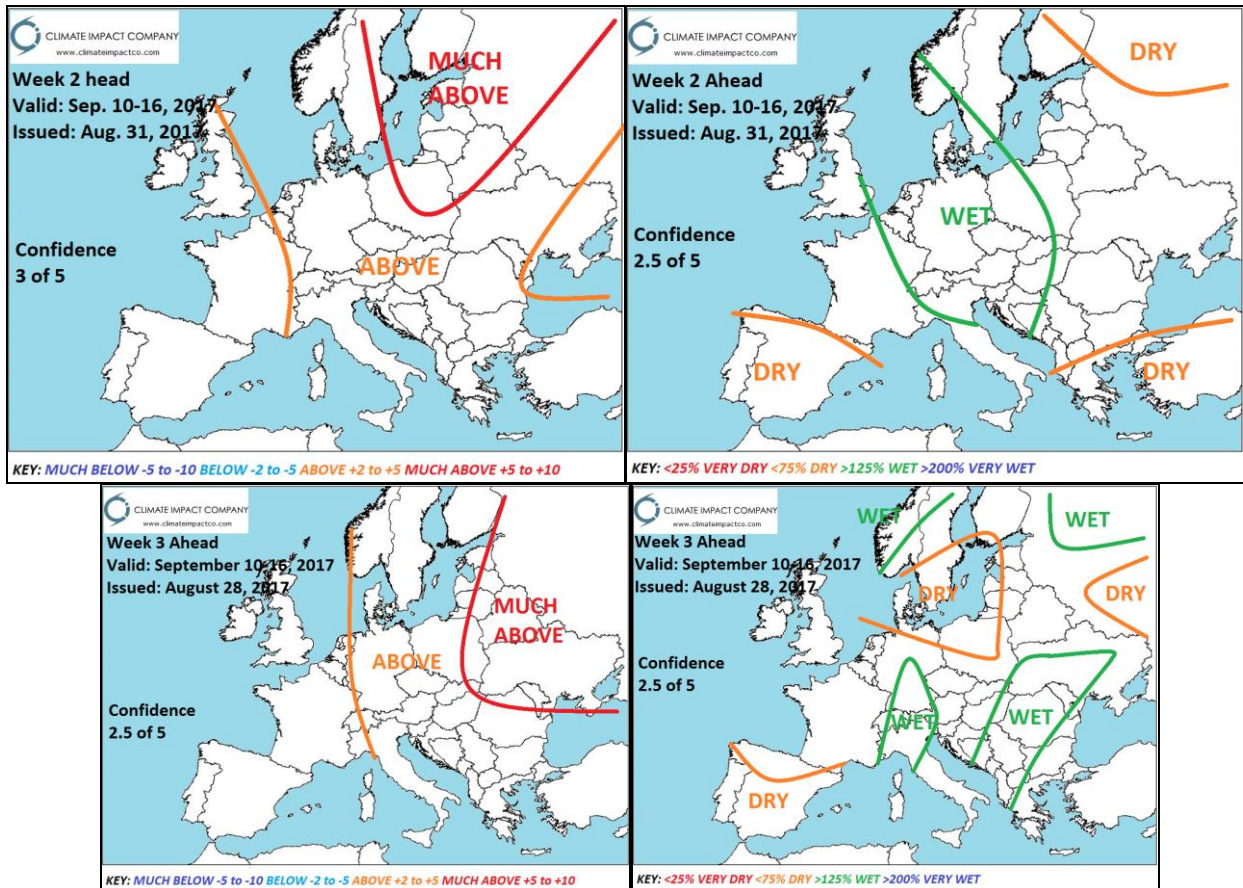


Climate Impact Company Intra-Seasonal (Week 2-4) Outlook for Europe

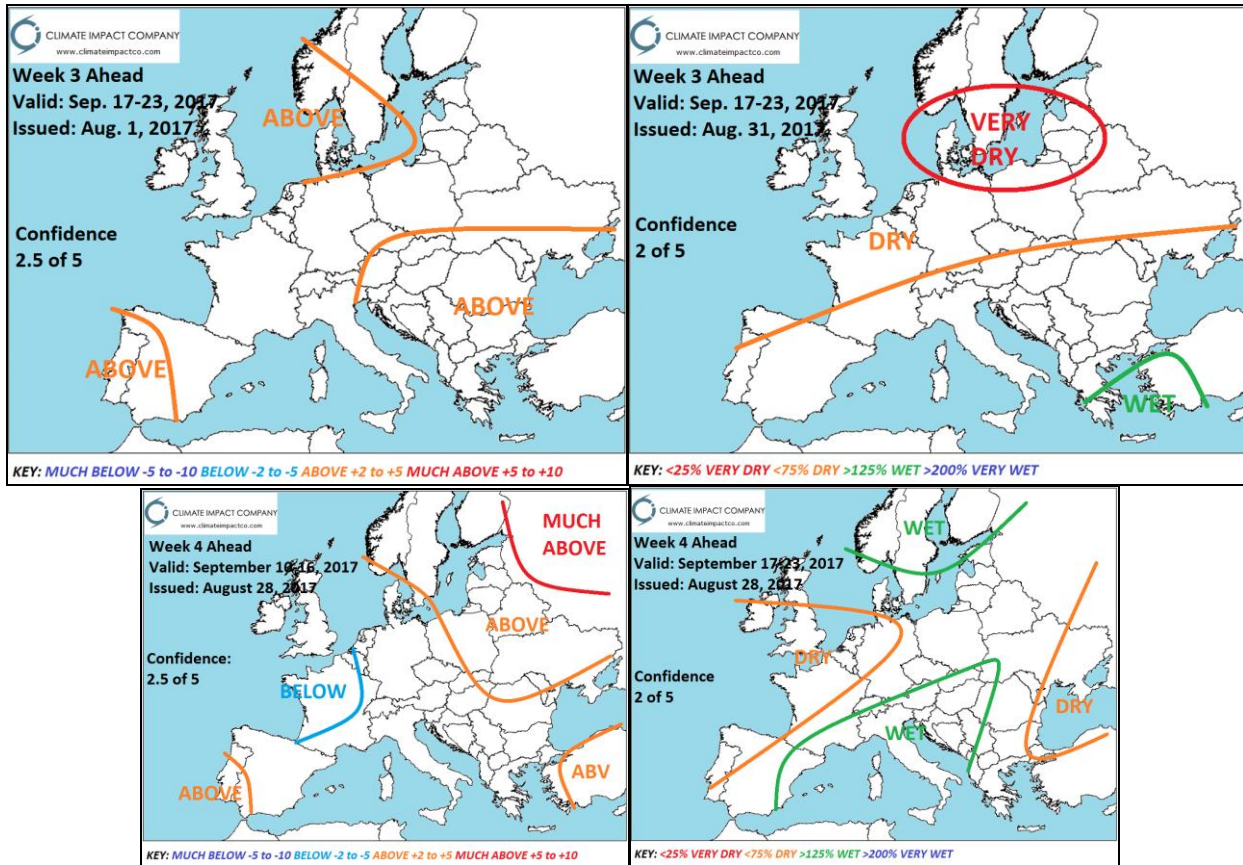

Week 2 Ahead: September 10-16, 2017 (previous forecast below)



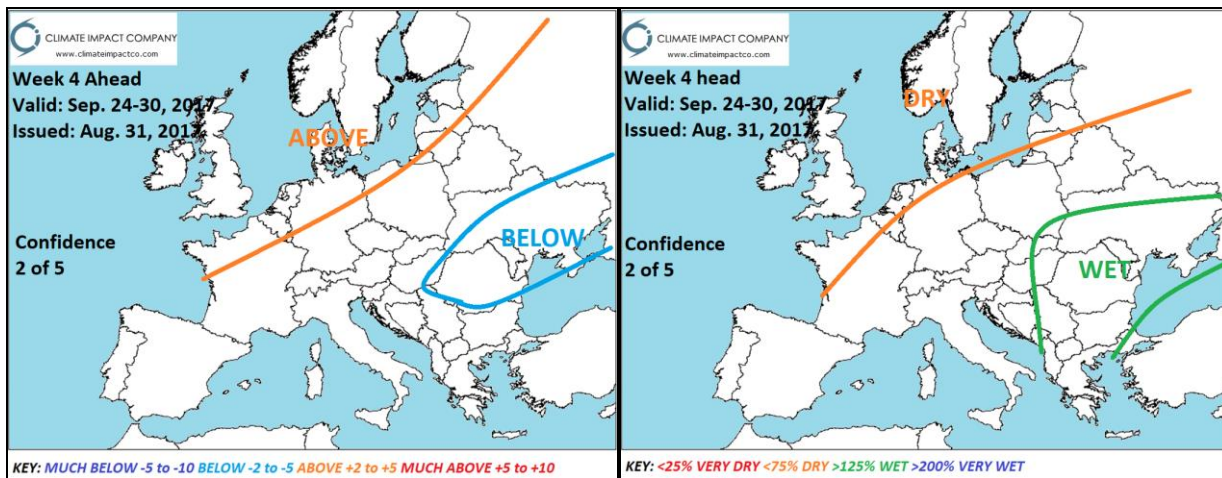
Comment: An upper trough produces rain across Central Europe while a somewhat warmer thermal pattern is anchored to the east across Western Russia. Far Southeast Europe stays dry.

Week 3 Ahead: September 17-23, 2017 (previous forecast below)



Comment: Potentially warmer than indicated for northern Europe while high pressure causes very dry climate across the Baltic nations to Central Europe.

Week 4 Ahead: September 24-30, 2017



Comment: Potential for evolution of a cool/wet trough in Southeast Europe to the Ukraine.
