


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## Climate Impact Company Intra-Seasonal (Week 2-4) Outlook for Europe Issued: Thursday, August 31, 2017

Week 2 Ahead: September 10-16, 2017 (previous forecast below)




**Comment:** An upper trough produces rain across Central Europe while a somewhat warmer thermal pattern is anchored to the east across Western Russia. Far Southeast Europe stays dry.
