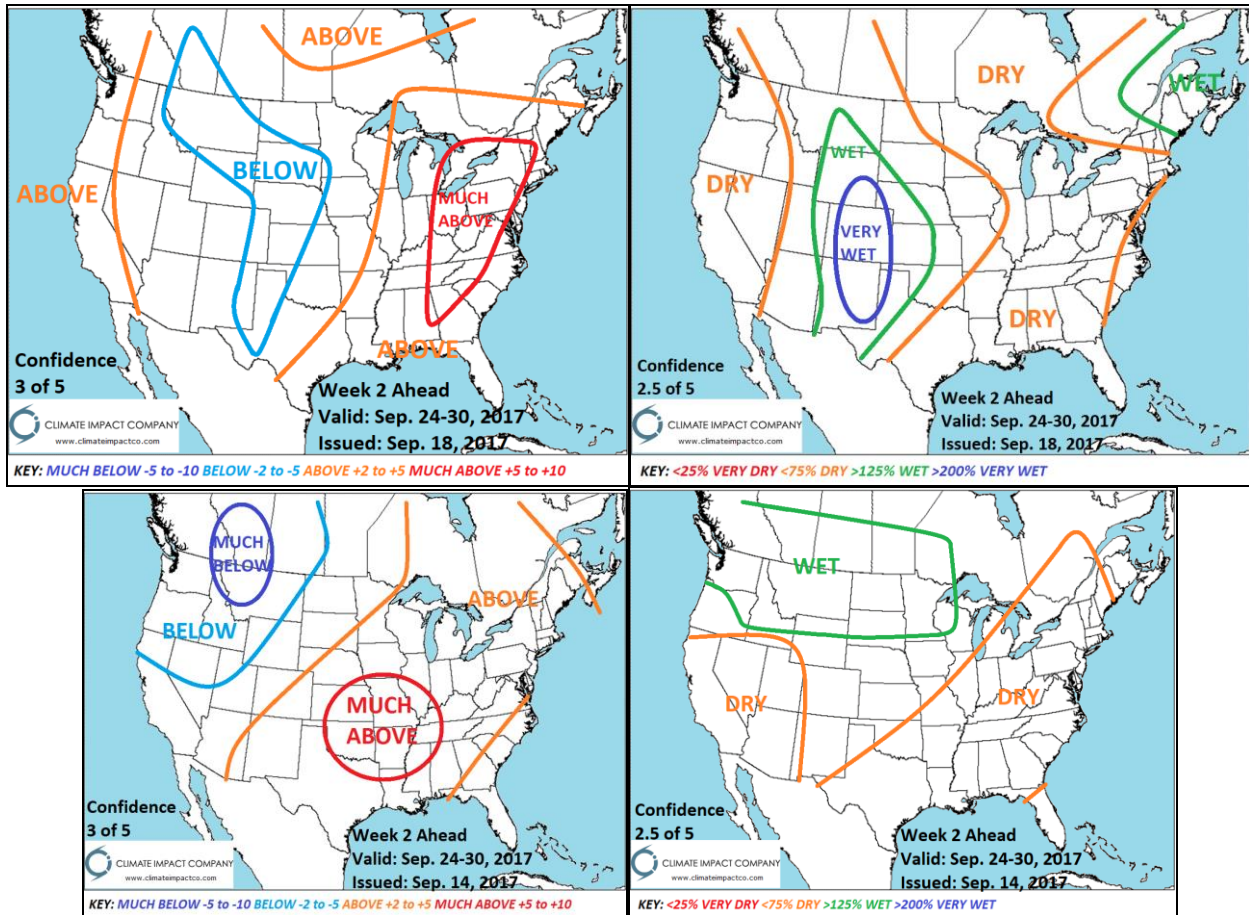


## Climate Impact Company Intra-Seasonal (Week 2-4) Outlook for the U.S.

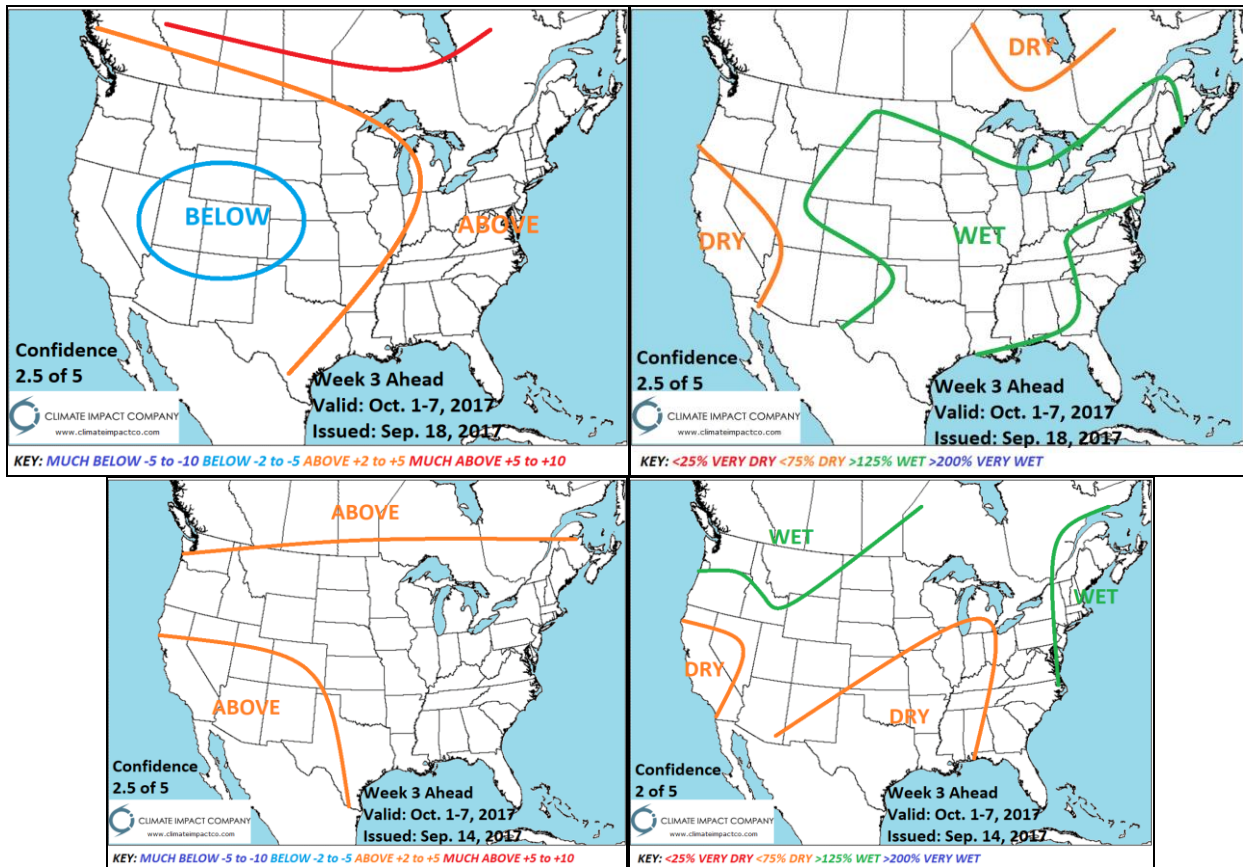

### Week 2 Ahead: September 24-30, 2017 (previous forecast below)



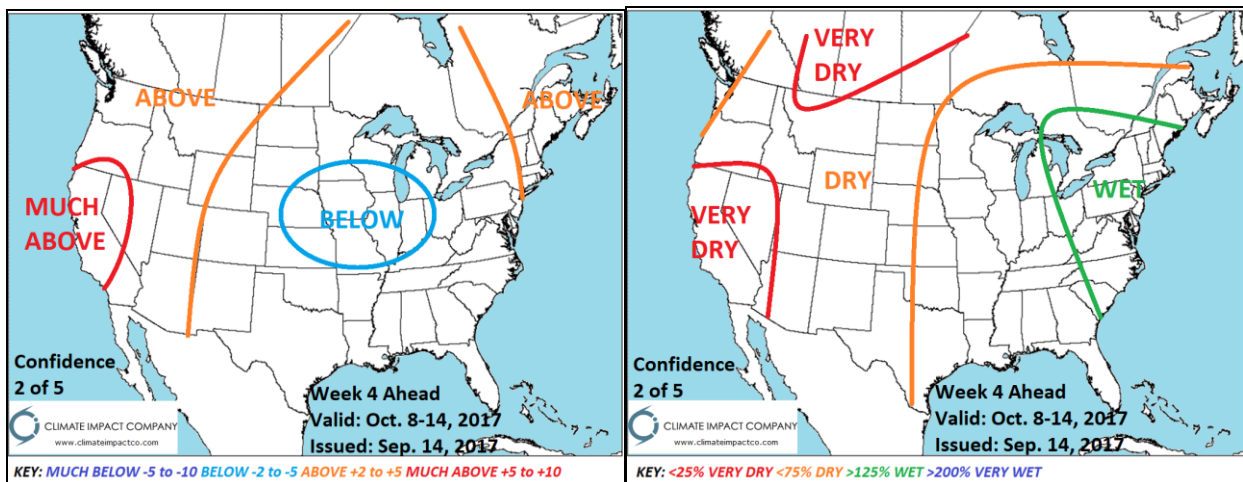
**Comment:** The western trough moves east and weakens while the eastern ridge is quite strong early in the period weakening by late week. The wet weather pattern in the Northwest this week shifts to the Great Plains next week. On the West Coast warming regenerates.

**Week 3 Ahead: October 1-7, 2017 (previous forecast below)**



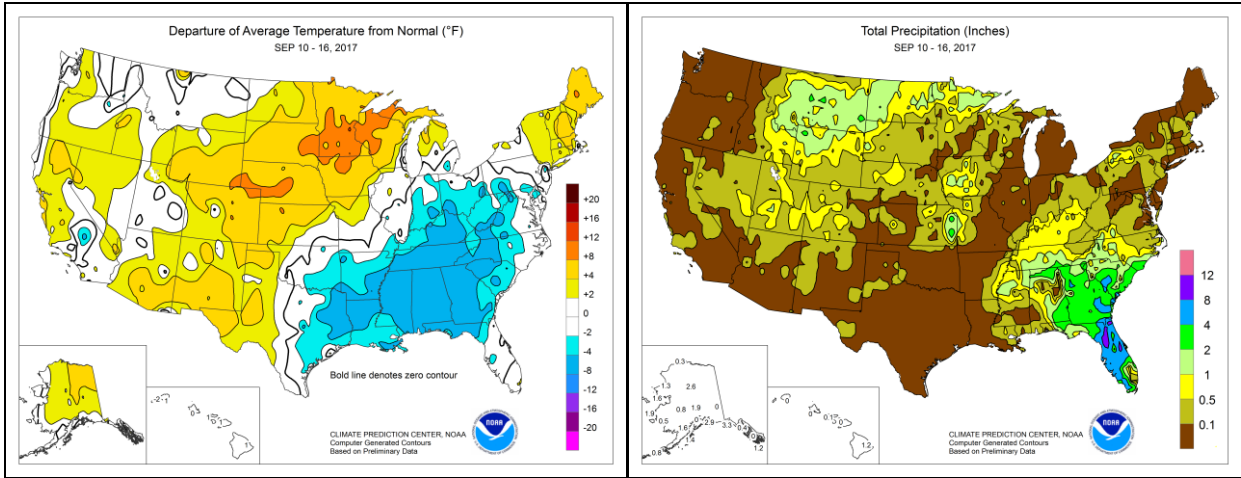
**Comment:** A cooler adjustment in the West-Central U.S. due to presence of an upper trough. The upper trough causes a wet regime in the Central/Northeast U.S.

**Week 4 Ahead: October 8-14, 2017**



**Comment:** Trending warmer West, cooler Midwest and rainy in the Northeast.
